Information for the applicants

- The deadline being so short, we agreed with the steering committee to offer a delay :
deadline for the applications is **January the 10th 2023 (midnight)**.
- The documents for the competition have to be sent in English for **January the 10th 2023 (midnight) by email** :

- The levels: Irish Students in year 1 and 2 of Level 7 may apply for STRAND1 (as long as Level 7 is a four-year programme) / Irish students in year 3 and 4 of Level 7 apply for STRAND2.
- An information online meeting will be held in French on **January the 5th 2023 at 3.30pm** (Irish time).

- The jury will examine the applications **between January the 11th to January the 15th 2023**.

- The jury members will send their conclusions by email on **January the 15th 2023**.
- An online meeting will be held with the jury members on **January the 16th 2023** (time to be agreed on).
- The results will be given on **January the 18th 2023**.
- Costs for the finalists and their lecturers are paid for by the hosting Lycée:
 - Transport of the finalists from their institute to Argelès-sur-Mer: a budget will be allocated to each finalist and his/her lecturer. They will have to sign an agreement saying that they will send their boarding passes, bills and invoices proving how the money is spent. If they finally don't participate they also agree to reimburse the money they received. The amount will be indicated soon.
 - Accommodation in Argelès-sur-Mer: finalists under 18 will be accommodated in the school in shared ensuite rooms of 4. Finalists over 18 will be accommodated in mobile homes in a nearby campsite (walkable distance / individual rooms / shared bathrooms). In both cases, sheets are provided but they will have to bring their own towels.
Considering that the results will be given in the evening, the finalists may have to consider staying 2 nights. (28th and 29th March 2023)
 - Food: Meals for the finalists and lecturers will be served in the school canteen.
- Material: all equipment is provided. Yet, finalists who want it can bring their own small cooking equipment like knives (authorization to be obtained before flying). Finalists have to bring their professional cooking/service outfit + safety shoes.
- Competition time table:
 - 8 to 8.30 : lecturers are allowed to enter the kitchen to prepare any equipment the finalists may need. No cooking is to be done at that moment.
 - 8.30 to 11.30 : cooking time
 - 11.30 to 12 : lunch break at the school canteen
 - 12 : service of the dishes to the jury members:
 - 12.20 : starter
 - 12.40 : main course
 - 1 : dessert
 - 1.30 to 2.30 : deliberation of the jury

The results will be announced before the Goût de France dinner (29th March 2023) and the prizes will be given at that moment. The finalists and their lecturers will have dinner in the school canteen.
